#### SECTION 4 — FIRST AID MEASURES

# SECTION 6 — ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Remove all ignition sources and ventilate area. Contain the spill with sand or other inert absorbent material, neutralize with sodium bicarbonate or calcium hydroxide, and deposit in a sealed bag or container. See Sections 8 and 13 for further information.

#### SECTION 7 — HANDLING AND STORAGE

Flinn Suggested Chemical Storage Pattern: Organic #1. Store with acids, anhydrides and peracids. Store away from nitric acid. Keep dry. Reacts violently with water. Should store in a dedicated acid cabinet or Flinn Saf-Cube<sup>™</sup>. Keep cool (P235). Keep container tightly closed (P233). Use only in a hood or in a well ventilated area.

#### SECTION 8 — EXPOSURE CONTROLS, PERSONAL PROTECTION

Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, and eye protection (P280). Wash hands thoroughly after handling (P264). Use only in a hood or in a well ventilated area.
